The Photographic Guild of Los Gatos was organized in 1969. It is composed of amateur and professional photographers who are interested in staying current in the fast-changing fields of photographic equipment and techniques.

The Guild meets on the third Friday of each month to hold informal discussions and exchange information. Various workshops are conducted on special techniques and new photographic processes. There are also frequent field trips, within California and abroad.

A major project of the Guild is to sponsor the annual photography contest, which is open to all junior photographers from high schools throughout the Bay Area. When the contest was first held in 1968, only 75 photos were entered. Over the years the competition has grown. This year there were 1,282 judged entries from 554 students representing 17 schools.

In 2007, the PGLG Educational Foundation was formed and obtained non-profit 501(c)(3) status. All contest donations are tax deductible.
